# NETBALL DIVISIONS

<b>SOCIAL 1</b>	This division is aimed at netball league teams who play club or action netball. This is the more serious teams.
<b>SOCIAL 2</b>	This is a more competitive social division. Teams to consist of PART TIME players (combination of social and club players) with 4 or less players who play club or action netball on a regular basis
<b>SOCIAL 3</b>	<p>This is the most social division. The teams that enter should consist of players who may have played netball at some point in their lives or know how to google netball rules. Teams may consist of lower/bottom league action netball players.</p> <p><b><i>NB: NO PROVINCIAL PLAYERS THAT HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THE LAST 3 YEARS ARE ALLOWED TO ENTER THIS DIVISION</i></b></p> <p><b><i>*NO SA PLAYERS</i></b></p>
<b>MIXED</b>	This league is aimed at mixed netball league teams. A maximum of 3 males on the court will be allowed and a minimum of 2.

# THE RULES

## NETBALL RULES AND DETAILS ACROSS ALL DIVISIONS

### SQUADS & REPLACEMENTS

- 10-person squad per team for a match
- All players can be substituted on during the match. Multiple substitution allowed during the games – WITH UMPIRE ACKNOWLEDGEMENT
- MATCH LENGTH
- All games will be:
  - 9 minutes a half (2 halves)
  - 2 minutes half time
  - 3 minutes between games
  - Run on 23minute slots

### POINTS/SCORING

- Round robin/pool games scoring:
  - 4 points are awarded for a win
  - 1 point is awarded for a draw
  - 0 points are awarded for a loss
  - Bonus point will be awarded for every 5 goals

If two or more teams end on level points, the position standing is determined by;

- The team who won the head to head match, if that was a draw, then;
  1. Team with the best 'for/against points difference' is the winner, if that is equal, then;
  2. Team scoring the most 'points for' is the winner, if that is equal, then;
- A coin toss will be done to determine the winner, if the coin lands on its side, then;
  - A Boat Race

2. In the event of a tie in the final, sudden death extra-time (3mins each way) is played, and the team scoring first is deemed the winner.



# THE RULES

## NETBALL RULES

- Normal netball rules will apply
- You are however allowed to do substitutions at any time during the match, after a goal is scored (before C-pass) and as often as you like.
- All players to be 18 years or older
- Fingernail length will be checked prior to playing
- No Gloves will be allowed
- No fitness watches around wrists will be allowed

## AGE RESTRICTIONS

- No u18s can participate in any of the sporting codes. I.e. You need to be 18+ on the event days
- If teams are found to have u18 player(s) in their team, the following process will take place:
- The player in question will be asked for their ID document or drivers license to prove that they are over 18 years
- If a valid ID document or drivers license is shown, games for that team will carry on as per the fixtures
- If no valid ID document or drivers license is shown, the below steps will apply
- The team captain and captain of 'informing' team (if applicable) will be brought together for a discussion with the sport manager
- The team at fault may forfeit their points for the current match as well as any preceding matches
- Unless stated otherwise by their opponent(s)
- The under-age player will need to leave the team and will no longer be allowed to take to the field/court for the remaining matches



# THE RULES

## NETBALL DISCIPLINE

- Event organisers and referees have the right to intervene if there is disrespectful, unruly or unsafe behaviour and play
- If a team does not arrive in time for the start of their game, the game will be considered a forfeit and a 21-0 winning score will be given to the punctual team - no exceptions, no excuses, final decision is in the hands of the match official.
- Normal disciplinary rules apply – warning, caution and then sent off if continue.

## 10s BLUE CARD

- A referee has a BLUE CARD that may be shown to a player at any stage of the match. A blue card enables the referee to send a player off for unsportsmanlike behaviour or for being disorderly/intoxicated on the field/court. The referee may use this card at his/her own discretion and their decision is final. This is to protect the safety of all players.
- The guilty player will have to leave the field/court for the remainder of the match.
- No substitutions will be allowed on for the remainder of the half that the guilty player was given the blue card.
- The team may replace the guilty player in the 2nd half if the incident happened in the 1st half.

## MIXED DIVISION

### FORMAT

- 1 group of 16 teams
- 16 teams split into 4 pools of 4 teams
- 3 Matches/team on Friday - Round robin format during pool stage
- 2 - 4 Matches on Saturday for Cup/Bowl/Plate/Shield positions
- Top 2 from each pool play in the Cup division
- Bottom 2 from each pool play in the Bowl section
- Loosing Cup quarter finalists play for the Plate
- Loosing Bowl quarter finalists play for the Shield

## SOCIAL DIVISION

### FORMAT

- 1 group of 16 teams
- 16 teams split into 4 pools of 4 teams
- 3 Matches/team on Friday - Round robin format during pool stage
- 2 - 4 Matches on Saturday for Cup/Bowl/Plate/Shield positions
- Top 2 from each pool play in the Cup division
- Bottom 2 from each pool play in the Bowl section
- Loosing Cup quarter finalists play for the Plate
- Loosing Bowl quarter finalists play for the Shield
